

# APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN THEOLOGICAL STUDIES PROGRAM

#### APPLICATION PROCEDURE

All documents submitted in support of this application become the property of St Stephen's College and are not returnable to the applicant or transferable to any third party. All materials will be kept strictly confidential. All materials must be received in order for your application to be considered complete. Keep a copy of the completed application packet for your files. Prospective students should submit the following documentation, in typed form where applicable:

- 1. The attached application form with required statements.
- 2. The non-refundable application fee.
- 3. Transcript(s): Official and Complete Transcript issued by the institution awarding the degree and certified by an authorized officer of that institution mailed directly to St Stephen's College; includes all courses taken and grades received for all years attended, is complete to the last date of attendance, and where applicable states the degree and the date the degree was or will be awarded. If the degree awarded includes transfer credits from other institutions, a transcript from the credit-granting institution is also required. Baccalaureate Degree must have GPA minimum 72%/B/3.0 during last 60 credits of course weight. Applicants should submit official transcripts for all academic work put forward in support of the application. Applicants whose transcripts are in a language other than English must submit certified translations of all transcripts being submitted as part of the application.
- 4. If language of instruction for prior degree was not English, proof of satisfactory score on an approved English language examination, referring to English Language Proficiency policy in Academic Calendar.
- 5. Curriculum vitae in summary form. This document should include:
  - Professional experience: Position, place, and duration
  - Post-secondary education: Degrees, diplomas and certificates held, with institutions and dates
  - Other experience, education or training related to proposed program
- 6. Two to three page statement of personal and professional goals in relation to the proposed course of study.
- 7. One page statement of your spiritual journey.
- 8. A sample of an academic paper or published article or other recent professional writing which demonstrates a capacity to integrate theory with practice.
- 9. Two letters of reference sent directly to College (using Reference Form which is part of the application).

Application deadline: Applications can be submitted throughout the year, with an annual application deadline of February 1 for Canadian and Permanent Resident applicants and November 1 for international applicants (next business day if date falls on a weekend). Applicants who do not possess a Baccalaureate Degree and who are applying for an evaluation of academic equivalency must submit their completed application to the College by December 1 for Canadian and Permanent Resident applicants and September 1 for international applicants.

### **EQUIVALENCIES PROCEDURE**

An application from persons who do not possess a Baccalaureate Degree will be considered if the applicant possesses satisfactory alternate educational experience. Equivalency is demonstrated by formal postsecondary education consisting of general and specialized studies comparable to a 90-credit Baccalaureate degree. In such cases, the Dean will require evidence of readiness to proceed. The Dean's decision whether or not to accept an application is final.

Prospective applications for whom special consideration is required should submit all supporting documentation (see Admission Requirements), together with any additional assessments, transcripts, and certificates earned in lieu of a Baccalaureate Degree. A non-refundable equivalency fee of \$225 must be included. The Dean's Office will review all documentation, and where it is deemed further exploration is warranted, may assign additional requirements to test eligibility. If equivalency is granted, the applicant will be invited to the intake process, and will pay the non-refundable regular application fee.
