BASIS OF NOMINATION

DOCTOR OF DIVINITY

The contributions would normally reflect meritorious service, outstanding leadership in denominational or ecumenical contexts, and/or outstanding commitment and contribution to ministry, whether ordered or lay.

This degree is awarded for excellence and/or outstanding contributions in one or more of the following areas:

1. Pastoral or missionary experience
2. Theological scholarship
3. Church statesmanship
4. Community responsibility

Therefore, for the DD(Hon) you are asked to comment on the following questions:

- 1 How has the nominee's life and work revealed her/his faith and commitment?
- 2 In what ways have the nominee's contributions been outstanding or special?

DOCTOR OF SACRED LETTERS

This degree is awarded for special contributions to the life and work of the church, the community, or the college which are not necessarily inclusive of faith ministry. The contributions would normally reflect meritorious service, outstanding leadership or scholarship of a high order which directly or indirectly furthers the objectives of the college. It would reflect excellence and/or outstanding contributions in such fields as:

- 1 service to the academic community
- 2 service to the community at large
- 3 contributions to philosophy, literature, the arts or spirituality which are complementary to the ideals of the college
- 4 exemplary service to the college not primarily of a theological nature
- 5 contributions to religious communities which are complementary to the ecumenical and inter-faith objectives of the college

Therefore, for the DSL(Hon) you are asked to comment on the following questions:

- 1 How has the nominee's life and work shown service to the college or wider community?
- 2 In what ways have the nominee's contributions been complementary to the ideals of the college?
