With the coming of spring, the College is celebrating the completion of the interior renovation to make the building accessible to persons with mobility challenges.

Clark Builders has done a wonderful job of reconfiguring two former rooms on the lower floor into a wheelchair accessible washroom and two smaller offices. The large L-shaped library space can now be separated into two rooms by a moveable divider to make that space more flexible. The “art studio” side of that space includes a sink and cupboards, and a much-needed large paper storage cupboard. The art supply cupboards, currently under construction, will be finished and installed by May 1.

An accessible janitor’s sink is now in place as well as a new high capacity hot water tank.

A late spring has delayed the exterior renovation which will include a new mobility accessible door at the west side of the building, a pull-out for vehicles on the road which runs along the south side of the College, a ramp from the pull-out to the entry

door, and landscaping to accommodate and complement the changed entry. As soon as the snow melts, Clark Builders will begin work on this second phase of the renovation.

We look forward to the day when we can invite you, our community of supporters, whose generosity is making this long-awaited project possible, and to celebrate with us the reality of having a building that is finally accessible to persons with mobility challenges.

In the meantime, we gratefully acknowledge the generosity of Don Wheaton, a major sponsor of the Annual Chancellor’s Gala’s which has raised funds for this renovation, the provincial Community Spirit Program, and the many supporters and friends of the College who have donated to the accessibility fund, purchased tables and tickets for the Galas, volunteered at the Gala, donated items to the Gala auctions and bid enthusiastically on those items.
